

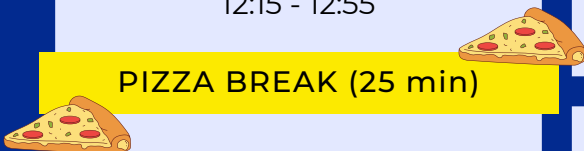

GENERAL RULES OF SPARING

1. Each team is obliged to designate a captain. Only the captain may communicate with the first referee and the scorekeeper.
2. Each team, through the captain, has the right to request one 30-second break during the set and to make two changes of players (also during one set). A player change may not take longer than 15 seconds.
3. Intentional extending of timeouts or player changing time by the team/captain will result in an additional point in the set for the opposing team.
4. Matches are played to two full sets (25 points) or no longer than 40 minutes. The two-point rule does not apply. A set is won by the team that first scores 25 points or has more points on its account after 40 minutes. In a situation where there is a point tie in the set after 40 minutes - the referee is required to order the last play, which will decide the winner. The referee must inform both teams about the last play in the match (in the case of a decisive point).
5. The winning team is determined by a table of points. In a situation where, after the end of all the games, the teams will have the same number of points on their account, then the winner will be decided by:
 - a) the ratio of sets won to lost;
 - b) the ratio of small points - won to lost.
6. Winning is determined by the points in the table at a given level (C, B-, B):
 - a) two sets won: 3 points;
 - b) a score of 1:1 in sets, 1 point for each team;
 - c) in a situation where only 1 set can be played in 40 minutes, 2 points go to the account of the team that won that set, and 1 point for the losing team.
7. In the case where the captain is not involved in the game in set/match he/she is still responsible for communication with the first referee and scorekeeper and requesting a break and change of players unless he/she appoints his/her playing deputy.
8. In other cases, the accepted and known rules of volleyball for referees shall apply.

MVP Choice

1. The MVP player is designated by the captain of the opposing team after each match played. The information about the selection of the MVP player shall be given by the captain only to the first referee.
2. In the case that after the completed games the number of MVP indications is the same for two or more players, then the decision of the judges and/or organizers shall be the deciding factor.
